We are very honoured and proud that one of the greatest living martial artists is taking the patronage of the Games: Grandmaster Stan Schmidt, 9th Dan ka-



National Karate Federation many years of Training and Courses

The Past ten years have been very exciting for the National Karate Federation in Scotland I have organised many special courses and enjoyed many special karate masters attending our Special Karate Festival. Several instructors come to mind we had the World Famous Stan Schmidt and Sensei Hideo Ochi who were outstanding teaching the Competitors, Instructors Referees and Judges They headed up nine other world master teaching at the 2001 WKC world championships held in Aberdeen Scotland. Since 2001 we have invited many special Instructors and with the help of Dr Fritz Wendland who has visited the courses bringing many excellent instructors to teach.

Fritz was instrumental in bringing Eiki Kurishita a 9th Dan in Gojo Ryu karate. The course was very different but very interesting. I remember with the training having quite a painful central body after Kurishita put us through his basic and Gojo Kata very interesting but different. We had also the pleasure of having Ken Wittstock attend our course he came from South Africa to Germany then came over to Scotland to attend our course. He is also a very dedicated Karate man and taught many interesting and applications of bunkai as well as many funny stories and tricks at our celebration party after the course this was another memorable course.

Over the years good friend from Norway Alf Rony Fagerland has attended our NFK course with his NKF Norway Squad. When I had a course in Norway with Alf Rony I was introduced to his karate friend Sensei Paul Kee from Sweden. Paul is an excellent Kata practitioner and has over 15 titles in Scandinavia. Between us we discuss the best way forward for our members, which is very helpful when you participate at WKC events. We also had Thomas Schulze 5th Dan, Julian Chees 5th Dan both Germany and Toni La Pietra 5th Dan from Italy. They are very fine Karateka and we really enjoyed training with them all. It is fantastic when you have not seen someone for a considerable time and they think and practice the same as you exactly. It's incredible like telepathy.


In the Past the Golden years of Shotokan I have trained with Master Keinosuke Enoeda the Shotokan Tiger. He came to Aberdeen to our club for 30 years. I also competed and trained at the then National courses. I look back with fond memories especially when I punched him on the body in a display on Scottish TV and ended up being kicked through the set of the studio. I also remember he was like a Tiger happy when fed but dangerous when hungry!! We had a very special Course with

Sensei Masatoshi Nakayama in 1984. I think in the UK I was the only one to have Nakayama for a Private course in the UK. I have a Nakayama clock that Nakayama gave Fritz at the course in Germany. Fritz kindly gave it to me. It is one of my special Karate possessions along with a presentation Black belt Enoeda gave me on passing 2nd Dan with his name on it. Now totally white and in shreds, which I wore for over 30 years training and competing.

Along with Enoeda we had Sensei Hiroshi Shirai, Sensei Taiji Kase both exceptional karate



men. I toured Norway with Kase and remember on my return I could not fasten my shirtsleeves because of the very severe blocking he used to dish out. I also remember being punched by Kase in the front of my body and the next morning I had black bruising on my back. Sensei Shirai also came to my courses many times. For me is one of the most beautiful karate exponents and his syllabus is outstanding. I have a private DVD training with him which we made with his permission this s also so another treasure. Sensei Kazunori Tsuyama accompanied with Master Omura also taught in Aberdeen. I had a special makiwara I used for punching, Tsuyama broke it with one kick. The Golden Years of Karate!

The Karate Festival will be held 8th -9th June 2013 and we look forward to another exciting festival. We have a Squad from France, Germany and Norway along with their instructors Alain Verbeeck 6th Dan a senior student of Sensei Kase in France, Paul Kee 7th Dan Sweden, Alf Ronny Fagerland 5th Dan NKF Norway.

Special guests will include Sensei Kase's daughter Sachiko Kase who wishes to meet her father's former student in Scotland. Also attending will be Mr Tarahara the Consul General of Japan and Lord Charles Bruce of Fife and Elgin, whose ancestors signed an agreement with Japan in 1860 and took the Marbles from the Parthenon in Greece for safekeeping. The Elgin marbles are now in the British Museum.

We are looking forward to an exciting Festival and International match in June 2013.

Spanish Karate Master 10th time in Japan

The Spanish Karate master Salvador Herraiz, has been a 7th Dan in Wado Ryu from 2009 and a has been a WKC member for many years. He has just recently made his tenth trip to Japan to meet several Karate masters.

Master Herraiz travelled to Japan with a few of his Karate students and spending the first week in Tokyo to meet Karate grandmasters like Goshi Yamaguchi, the son of the Goju legend Gogen Yamaguchi, after his father head of Japan Goju-Kai. He also took the opportunity to visit Hirokazu Kanazawa, 10th Dan Shotokan. Master Kanazawa is known as one of the most outstanding fighters in his early years and for 60 years he has been teaching excellent technique worldwide. Originally an ex-JKA Instructor he founded his own world body Shotokan Karate International Federation (SKIF) over 30 years ago. Kanazawa has influenced generations of karateka throug-






During this time S. Herraiz visited the old masters from the Keio University Karate club, a few of them direct students of Gichin Funakoshi, for example Mashimo, Kase, Iwamoto. He also had the opportunity to meet the first WUKO World Champion 1970 Koji Wada. At the end of this visit he dropped in to see again the Wado Ryu Honbu Dojo of the late Hironori Ohtsuka-Sensei where Herraiz trained 25 years ago.

After this the Spanish karate group travelled to Okinawa to see the masters Masahiro Nakamoto (Bunbukan dojo), Minoru Higa (Kyudokan dojo Shorin Ryu), Eikou Miyazato (Goju Ryu, Kobudo and Okinawan dance show), Tetsuhiro Hokama (10th Dan Goju Ryu), Zempo Shimabujuro (10th Dan Seibukan), Fusei Kise (10th Dan Kenshinkan), Isamu Arakaki (10th Dan Rengo Kai organization) and Meitetsu Yagi, 10th Dan Meibukan dojo Goju Ryu). Finally S. Herraiz, together with Spain based Master Ryoichi Onaga, 8th Dan, visited Master Yoshio Hichiya (10th Dan Goju Ryu).

Without question Master Herraiz is one of the most productive authors on traditional karate in the world. He has met, interviewed, and trained with so many international karate masters from the main styles Goju, Shoto, Wado, Shorin and Shito during his career of over 40 years.
